Your understanding and assistance in this matter is appreciated. When completed, Coastal will invoice you for the \$69.00 fee.



DUMPSTERS – PLEASE HELP KEEP THESE AREAS CLEAN

Now that we are well into summer it is even more important to be careful with garbage and recycling at our dumpsters. Our pest control company is treating the dumpster areas for fly infestations. We are working with Waste Management to get the garbage picked up. They have been asked to replace Dumpster #2 because it is leaking. We're waiting for that to be done.

Please make sure your garbage is bagged before putting it in the dumpsters. Close the dumpster doors securely after depositing your trash. If the dumpster is full, you can check on the other side of the dumpster to deposit it or go to one of the other dumpsters in the Complex. Do NOT leave garbage outside of the dumpsters – not on the ground, not on top of the dumpster!

St. John's County requires all dogs and cats to be vaccinated for rabies according to the schedule mandated by the vaccine / veterinarian. Also, animals must be on a leash when outside your unit. You are responsible for picking up waste from your animals and depositing it in an appropriate trash container. Please refrain from letting your animals urinate on our hedges or flowering areas, especially close to the buildings and walkways.

THEN AND NOW; 50 YEARS OF VETERANS EXPERIENCES' ART EXHIBIT

Demonstrating the healing power of art, the exhibit features paintings, sculpture, photography,

poetry and other creative outlets. A replicated 5-by-8 foot holding cell will be one of the exhibit highlights. The art installation honors Army Major (RET) Theodore Gostas, a former POW held in captivity for five years during the Vietnam War.

In addition to the Vietnam War, artistic works represent 50 years of military history from the Cold War to conflicts in the Middle East. The veterans whose art will be displayed have served around the world in Europe, Vietnam, Cuba, Iraq, Afghanistan, Japan and Bosnia as well as other locations.

Admission is free; open from: 1 to 4 p.m. Tuesday–Sunday; through Aug. 22, 2021. The St. Augustine Art Association is located at 22 Marine Street.

ST. AUGUSTINE MUSIC FESTIVAL: CLASSICAL MUSIC CONCERT

On Friday, August 20th, from 7:30 – 10:00 PM, the St. Augustine Music Festival will present an evening of Paganini, Alexander Borodin and Ravel at the Cathedral Basilica of St. Augustine at 38 Cathedral Place.
