Paper & Cardboard:

does not go in recycling!

Newspapers, magazines, catalogs, junk mail (window in a window envelope must be removed), office paper, cereal/food boxes, and flattened cardboard.

Plastic Containers:

Clean and empty food and beverage containers, soap bottles and jugs, empty pill bottles (remove all caps). Labels do not need to be removed. NO STYROFOAM, NO PLASTIC BAGS; NO BUBBLE WRAP.

Cartons:

Clean and empty milk, juice, soup, broth, and wine cartons.

Glass:

Bottles & Jars (clear, green, & brown) only. NO WINDOWS, MIRRORS, OR CERAMIC CONTAINERS.

Metal:

Aluminum & metal food and beverage containers only (clean and empty).
