All owners must have their dryer vents cleaned every other year (odd years, so this is one of those years). You are responsible for getting this done by a licensed and insured vendor (not a handyman) and must provide Coastal with a copy of the receipt. This must be done by 12/31/23. HURRICANE PREPAREDNESS

We are into the Atlantic Hurricane Season - June 1st thru November 30th. You can get information about how to be prepared if a hurricane visits our area at: <https://www.sjcemergencymanagement.com> where you can download all kinds of important information like an evacuation map (we are in Evacuation Zone C), checklists, shelter information (closest shelters to us on Route 206 are Pedro Menendez High School and, further west on 206, South Woods Elementary School). Don't forget that you are responsible for removing all items from your lanai if a storm is imminent.

HOT WEATHER AND GARBAGE – SEAL IT UP! RECYCLING REMINDERS

GARBAGE: Our hot and steamy weather is here. Please make sure any garbage you put in the

dumpsters is bagged and tightly tied closed to help keep things from getting messy and stinky during the summer months!

RECYCLING: only these five types of items can be put in the recycling.

Paper & Cardboard:

Newspapers, magazines, catalogs, junk mail, office paper, cereal/food boxes, and FLATTENED cardboard boxes.

Plastic Containers:

Clean and empty food and beverage containers, soap bottles and jugs, empty pill bottles. Labels do not need to be removed. NO STYROFOAM®, NO PLASTIC BAGS.

Cartons:

Clean and empty milk, juice, soup, broth, and wine cartons.

Glass Bottles & Jars:

Clear, green, & brown only. NO windows or ceramic containers.

Metal:

Aluminum & metal food and beverage containers only (clean and empty).

JULY 4th FIREWORKS

Enjoy the fabulous fireworks display over the Matanzas Bay from downtown St. Augustine. The fireworks will start at 9:30 PM and last for 20 minutes; they are

choreographed to patriotic music. Some of the best vantage points are the Bridge of Lions and Castillo de San Marcos. There will be a concert of "big band" music beginning at 6:00 PM in the Plaza de la Constitución. Road closures begin at 8:00 PM and don't end until 11:00 PM, so plan accordingly.
