#### APRIL 8<sup>TH</sup> – TOTAL SOLAR ECLIPSE

On Monday, April 8<sup>th</sup> there will be a total solar eclipse; the path of totality for this eclipse runs through Mexico, the United States, and Canada, with a 62% eclipse visible here in St. Augustine. Here is a website to give you lots of information about the Eclipse, including time and how to <u>safely</u> watch the eclipse.

The Time and Date website will have a live broadcast of the eclipse. According to NASA, after the total solar eclipse on April 8th 2024, the next total solar eclipse that can be seen from the contiguous United States will be on August 23rd, 2044! However, the path of totality for that eclipse will only touch three U.S. states; with the eclipse beginning
